Privacy Policy

OUR COMMITMENT TO PRIVACY

Hungry and Thirsty knows how much you care about your privacy and how your information is used and shared. This Privacy Policy describes how your personal information is collected, used, and shared when you visit or make a donation on hungryandthirsty.com (the "Site"). It applies to donor information that we collect both online and offline. This Privacy Policy

Hungry and Thirsty will not sell, share or trade our donors' names or personal information with any other entity.

SECTION 1 - WHAT INFORMATION IS COLLECTED BY HUNGRY AND THIRSTY?

We collect personal information when you voluntarily submit it to us.

For example, donors may provide us with personal information (such as name, address, email address, telephone numbers and/or credit/debit card information). If a donor, or a website visitor, contacts us by email they may provide us with their email address, and name. Providing data is required in these contexts in order for us to process your donations, requests, or respond to inquiries. You may be added to our general distribution mailing list, if requested, and may be sent periodic updates about the work of Hungry and Thirsty.

This site contains links to other sites. Hungry and Thirsty is not responsible for the privacy practices or the content of such Web sites.

SECTION 2 - WE COLLECT DEVICE INFORMATION USING THE FOLLOWING TECHNOLOGIES:

When you visit the Site, we automatically collect certain information about your device, including information about your web browser, IP address, time zone, and some of the cookies that are installed on your device. Additionally, as you browse the Site, we collect information about the individual web pages or products that you view, what websites or search terms referred you to the Site, and information about how you interact with the Site. We refer to this automatically-collected information as "Device Information."

- "Cookies" are data files that are placed on your device or computer and often include an anonymous unique identifier. For more information about cookies, and how to disable cookies, visit http://www.allaboutcookies.org.
- "Log files" track actions occurring on the Site, and collect data including your IP address, browser type, Internet service provider, referring/exit pages, and date/time stamps.
- "Web beacons," "tags," and "pixels" are electronic files used to record information about how you browse the Site.

Google analytics:

Our store uses Google Analytics to help us learn about who visits our site and what pages are being looked at.

Additionally when you make a donation online through the Site, we collect certain information from you, including your name, billing address, shipping address, payment information (including credit card numbers, email address, and phone number. We refer to this information as "Donor Information"

When we talk about "Personal Information" in this Privacy Policy, we are talking both about Device Information and Donor Information.

Finally, we may also share your Personal Information to comply with applicable laws and regulations, to respond to a subpoena, search warrant or other lawful request for information we receive, or to otherwise protect our rights.

As described above, we use your Personal Information to provide you with targeted advertisements or marketing communications we believe may be of interest to you. SECTION 4 - YOUR RIGHTS

If you are a European resident, you have the right to access personal information we hold about you and to ask that your personal information be corrected, updated, or deleted. If you would like to exercise this right, please contact us through the contact information below.

Additionally, if you are a European resident we note that we are processing your information in order to fulfill contracts we might have with you (for example if you make an order through the Site), or otherwise to pursue our legitimate business interests listed above.

Additionally, please note that your information will be transferred outside of Europe, including to Canada and the United States.

SECTION 5 - DATA RETENTION

When you place a donation through the Site or by mail, we will maintain your information for our records unless and until you ask us to delete this information.

SECTION 6 - HOW WE PROTECT YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We take reasonable physical, technical, and organizational measures to protect the personal information collected on our websites. Of course, no method of transmission over the Internet or electronic storage is 100% secure. As we deem appropriate, we use security measures consistent with industry standards. However, we cannot guarantee the security of our databases, nor can we guarantee that information you provide us won't be intercepted during transmission over the Internet. In the event that we are required by law to inform you of a breach to your personal information we may notify you electronically, in writing, or by telephone, if permitted to do so by law.

SECTION 7 - AGE OF CONSENT

By using this site, you represent that you are at least the age of majority in your state or province of residence, or that you are the age of majority in your state or province of residence and you have given us your consent to allow any of your minor dependents to use this site

It is our policy not to knowingly collect personal information from individuals under the age of 13. If you are a parent/guardian and you suspect that your child may have submitted personal information to us, please send us an email.
